1. The petitioner appears in-person. He has tendered his affidavit dated 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2025. The same is taken on record. In the said affidavit, the petitioner has categorically stated that he wants to withdraw the petition, since it was filed without his consent. He has further stated in the affidavit that he had sent an official mail to

Advocate Mr. Hulyalkar, requesting him to withdraw the petition, however, despite multiple reminders, whatsapp messages and communications, the said petition was not withdrawn. He has further stated in the affidavit, that the petition was filed without taking his signature and without his consent and was filed on the basis of the vakalatnamas taken from the petitioner to file his bail application. He has also stated that the vakalatnama was signed by him not for filing the aforeaid petition in this Court. The said affidavit is taken on record and marked 'X' for Identification.

2. The petitioner who appears in person, seeks leave to withdraw the aforesaid petition with liberty to file a fresh petition as and when the occasion so arises. Leave granted.

3. Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed.
