2. By this Application, the Applicant seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with C. R. No. 150 of 2019 registered with the Oshiwara Police Station, Mumbai, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 376, 376(2)(N), 354(D), 500, 506, 342, 323 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 66(D) of the Information Technology Act.

3. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that the allegations as against the Applicant are false and baseless. He further

submits that the relations between the Applicant and the prosecutrix, aged 27 years were consensual. He submits that the Applicant is ready to handover his mobile phone to the investigating officer and also undertakes to this Court not to contact the Complainant / Prosecutrix on any social media / website.

4. Learned APP to take detailed instructions.

5. In the meantime, till the next date, the Applicant is granted interim protection on the following terms & conditions :-

ORDER

(i) In the event of arrest, the Applicant be enlarged on bail, on executing P. R. Bond in the sum of **Rs. 25,000/-** with one or two sureties in the like amount;

(ii) The Applicant shall report to the investigating officer of the concerned police station on **20th & 21st August, 2019** between **10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon** and thereafter, as & when called for by the investigating officer;

(iii) The Applicant shall handover his mobile phone to the investigating officer;

(iv) The Applicant shall not tamper with the evidence or

attempt to influence or contact the Complainant / Prosecutrix, on any social media / website, much less threaten her or witnesses or any person concerned with the case.

6. Stand over to **05.09.2019**. To be listed on the **Supplementary Board**.
